# Row after women told to take off innerwear at NEET centre

**THIRUVANANTHAPURAM:** Reports that girl students appearing for the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) held on Sunday at a centre in Ayyur, 55km from the Kerala capital, were forced to remove their innerwear for security reasons have shocked the nation. Parents are up in arms, the state police have launched an investigation, and the Kerala education minister has said she will take up the matter with the National Testing Agency.

The NTA said that it has taken note of the incident and will take appropriate action.

The incident, at Marthoma Institute of Technology in Ayyur, would have likely gone unnoticed if not for a complaint by the father of one of the girls. Police said that

though many girls faced a similar treatment they were not willing to complain out of shame. "We have recorded the statement of the father and girl who complained. We will record statements of more," said Deputy SP V Vijayakumar. He said a case will be registered soon.

Officials at Marthoma Institute of Technology in Ayyur claimed their employees were not involved. "Two agencies were assigned for frisking and noting biometric attendance. Their staff carried out the whole process..." said an official of the college who asked not to be named. He said 520 students appeared for the test and after the examination some girl students came to the college officials and complained about "adamant behaviour of some of the women staff (conducting the exam)".

"My daughter was in tears after she came out of the examination hall... She was forced to remove her bra after the metal detector beeped. Shocked, she was not able to write properly," said the agitated father from Kollam who filed a complaint with the rural SP.

Kerala higher education Minister R Bindhu termed the incident

"inhuman and shocking" and the state human rights commission has directed the Kollam rural police superintendent to inquire into the incident and submit a report in two weeks.

The state's women rights commission registered a case. "It is a most despicable act. We will seek explanation from all concerned including NTA," said commission member Shahida Kamal.

NTA later issued an official statement about the incident, saying that the exam centre superintendent, the independent observer and city coordinator for Kollam district "did not find any such incident at the centre". "The candidate did take the examination. There was no representation/complaint to any one during or immediately after the examination. Nor has NTA received any email/complaint in this regard," it said.

# Two NEET aspirants allege college forced them to remove burqa, hijab

**NAGPUR:** Five Muslim students, appearing for the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) at a centre in Maharashtra's Washim district, were allegedly asked to remove their hijab and burqa citing security reasons, police said on Monday.

The incident, which took place at Washim's Matoshri Shantabai Gote College on Sunday, triggered protests in the area. Two of the students - Ariba Hussain and Iram Mohd Zakir - also approached the police, seeking action against the college authorities.

"The staff involved in checking students made objectionable remarks like threatening to cut the burqa-hijab if they didn't remove it voluntarily," said G Hussain, Ariba's father.

A student, who spoke on the condition of anonymity, said the college authorities initially allowed them on the premises for the exam but later told them to remove their hijabs and burqas. "We asked them to check us and allow us in, but the staff spoke to us disrespectfully," the student alleged.

"We have received a complaint that two girls were asked to remove their burqa and hijab (face veil) at Matoshri Shantabai Gote College. Their application to the police claims that the staff involved in checking students made objectionable remarks like threatening to cut the burqa-hijab if they didn't remove it voluntarily.

A probe has been launched into the matter," said Bachan Singh, SP, Washim district.

The college principal, however, said the students were asked to remove their hijab "so that they do not indulge in acts like copying".

"Five girl students, who came at the examination centre wearing hijab, were asked to remove their hijab so that they do not indulge in acts like copying. A couple of students reported late," principal GS Kubade said. The official guidelines for such national examinations say candidates should wear casual and weather-appropriate clothing, he added.

Inspector Rafiq Shaikh, who is investigating the matter, said the matter was later resolved amicably and all five took the exam.

SC TO HEAR FRESH PLEA BY NUPUR SHARMA TODAY ON CLUBBING FIRS

**NEW DELHI:** The Supreme Court will hear on Tuesday a petition by suspended Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) spokesperson Nupur Sharma seeking to recall the order by which she withdrew the plea to consolidate multiple FIRs filed against her across the country over her remarks on Prophet Mohammed as the court was not inclined to entertain her petition.

The application will be heard by a bench of justices Surya Kant and JB Pardiwala. On July 1, the same bench had denied any relief to Sharma and asked her to withdraw her plea.

In a fresh application filed on July 9, Sharma told the Court that she faced arrest in multiple cases registered against her and sought protection from arrest and sought protection from arrest in first information reports (FIRs) filed against her in Delhi, Maharashtra, Telangana, West Bengal, Karnataka, UP, Assam and the Union Territory of J&K.

Sharma's comments about Prophet Mohammed during a TV debate in May had led to a major diplomatic row following which, the BJP at the Centre distanced itself from the controversy and suspended Sharma.

On July 1, the top court had refused to entertain her plea for consolidating the multiple criminal cases as it passed scathing comments on her conduct by terming her "loose tongue" to be responsible for the violence in the country, including the killing of a tailor in Udaipur in June.

The order passed by the top court had come under criticism from several quarters as a former Delhi high court judge, justice (ret'd) SN Dhingra, found the SC bench's comments to be "unfair" and "irresponsible".

# School bus driver held for raping minor: Cops

revealed what had happened to her after which the case was lodged. We have arrested the accused who is currently in police custody," said Patil.

"We have invoked the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (Pocso) Act, 2012 and the accused has been arrested," added Patil.
